Local Law No. 7 of the year 19 83

A local law increasing the salaries of certain County officials

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the

1. The salary of the County Attorney shall be increased in the sum of \$1,751 effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1983, the annual salary of the County Attorney shall be \$30,929.

2. The salary of the Commissioners of Election shall be increased in the sum of \$1,096, each, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to January 1, 1983, the annual salary of the Commissioners of Election shall be \$19,364 each.

3. The salary of the Public Defender shall be increased in the sum of \$1,287 effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1983, the annual salary of the Public Defender shall be \$22,743.

4. The salary of the Commissioner of Public Health shall be increased in the sum of \$2,984, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1983, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Public Health shall be \$52,724.

5. The salary of the Probation Director shall be increased in the sum of \$1,670, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1983, the annual salary of the Probation Director shall be \$29,501.

6. The salary of the County Auditor shall be increased in the sum of \$1,288, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1983, the annual salary of the County Auditor shall be \$22,755.

7. The salary of the Purchasing Agent shall be increased in the sum of \$1,319, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactive to January 1, 1983, the annual salary of the Purchasing Agent shall be \$23,308.

8. The salary of the Commissioner of Parks & Recreation shall be increased in the sum of \$1,469, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to January 1, 1983, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Parks & Recreation shall be \$25,951.

9. The salary of the Commissioners of Civil Service shall be increased in the sum of \$178.00 each, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to January 1, 1983 the annual salary of the Commissioners of Civil Service shall be \$3,145 each.

10. The salary of the Director of Real Property Tax Services shall be increased in the sum of \$1,209, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from May 1st, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to May 1st, 1983, the annual salary of the Director of Real Property Tax Services shall be \$21,351.

11. The salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be increased in the sum of \$2,137, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to January 1, 1983, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be \$37,759.

12. The salary of the County Treasurer shall be increased in the sum of \$5,040, effective 45 days after adoption of this Local Law with a lump sum installment to be paid as soon as possible for the past services rendered from January 1, 1983, and the balance of the increase to be paid in equal installments over the remaining pay periods. Effective retroactively to January 1, 1983, the annual salary of the County Treasurer shall be \$33,040, for the three (3) years ending December 31, 1985, without further increment.

13. One day's pay shall be held back from each official's salary, other than the County Treasurer's, on five alternate pay periods commencing with the first pay period after the salaries become fixed by operation of law until five full day's pay have been withheld from each official.

14. This Local Law shall become effective 45 days after the adoption of same.
