MOTOR EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Employees in this class perform recurring manual duties in connection with the operation and specialized maintenance repair of moderately complex motor equipment. Performs all types of maintenance requiring hydraulic welding or other specialized trade. Operates one or more types of automotive equipment and performs a variety of manual tasks in connection with such operation. Incumbents receive general direction from a superior but are responsible for the safe and economical operation and care of their equipment on assigned tasks. Periodic inspections are made of work in progress. Supervision is exercised over Motor Equipment Operators and Laborers. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

1. Supervises the work of an assigned group of Motor Equipment Operators and Laborers;
2. Operates a truck in connection with the collection of garbage, ashes, snow and in the transportation of sand, stone, gravel and supplies;
2. Operates a tractor or truck with power mower, trailer, snow loader, bulldozer, concrete mixer, stone crusher or other attachment;
3. Operates a power grader, steam roller, snow plow, power shovel, or backhoe, and all other related equipment;
4. Occasionally performs minor repairs and maintenance on automotive equipment;
5. Performs manual labor, such as loading trucks, erecting snow fences, landscaping, building and ground maintenance, cleaning culverts, repairing and constructing roads, and flagman duties;
6. May be assigned to installing and maintenance of water and sewer facilities;
7. Maintains inventory records;
8. May be assigned to supervise the installation of culvert pipes or the removal of trees by private contractors;
9. When necessary, maintains records and completes reports.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good knowledge of the operation of tractors, trucks and other automotive equipment; thorough knowledge in hydraulic welding, electrical repair or other specialized trade; ability to understand and follow simple oral and written directions; ability to lead the work of others and provide supervision; mechanical aptitude; industry; dependability. Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Two (2) years of experience in the operation of some type of automotive equipment. One (1) year of experience shall have been in the field of hydraulic welding, electrical repair or other specialized trade.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS:

Must have a Class III License L. 1972. If a motor equipment operator is required to operate a tractor-trailer combination, he or she will be required to have Class I License. Possession of an alternate applicable license is acceptable when application is accompanied by an administrative letter stating that the candidate will not operate a motor vehicle contrary to the Vehicle and Traffic Law of New York State.
