MASONRY WORKER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This skilled work involving responsibility for independently performing a variety of masonry, pointing, brick work, concrete work and related work. Will be assigned to participate in regular building maintenance work such as, but not limited to, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, painting, etc. General instructions are received and work is performed under immediate or general supervision, depending upon nature of tasks. Performs a variety of skilled and semi-skilled building repairs, principally masonry work and general maintenance tasks. Does related work as assigned.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

1. Perform skill work in masonry field such as brick laying, concrete work, pointing, etc.
2. Perform plastering, patching work, walls, ceilings, etc.
3. Assist skilled mechanics in all buildings maintenance, plumbing electrical, boiler and other repairs or installations.
4. May be assigned to perform other off-season duties such as painting.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Thorough working knowledge of cement and masonry work. Ability to safely operate bucket trucks, power scissor lifts, suspend powered or mechanical scaffolding, span scaffolding and other related equipment. Some knowledge of regular building maintenance, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, etc. Ability to get along with others. Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Completion of an elementary school course;

AND: Five (5) years of experience and training in work involving all areas of masonry work;

OR: Graduation from high school or possession of a New York State Equivalency diploma and three (3) years of the above experience.

***SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:** Must have or filed and working toward receiving Journeyman's papers in an authorized program for this field.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a valid New York State Motor Vehicle license to operate vehicles used in this field. Per C.S.C. Action 4/24/89.
